
Proclamation

- Whereas,* since December of 1978, the Clinics at Scranton Primary Health Care Center, a Federally Qualified Health Center, has lived its mission of providing quality medical and dental services to the underserved at a reasonable cost to the community. Last year, the agency served approximately 8,800 patients, which resulted in nearly 30,000 visits to the center;
- Whereas,* Scranton Primary has grown from its humble beginnings of offering women's health care to now more than 50 center employees providing services to the area. Over the last 36 years, it has expanded to include internal medicine, pediatrics, gynecology, a prenatal clinic, a dental center, and outreach to Lackawanna County's homeless population;
- Whereas,* the Center will continue to respond to the evolving trends and needs of its patient population and local community. The facility is a provider of medical and dental care to everyone, regardless of the clients' ability to supply compensation. No one is refused care due to an inability to pay; and
- Whereas,* today, we recognize the Clinics at Scranton Primary Health Care Center, Inc. and celebrate National Health Care Center Week with a community health fair.


